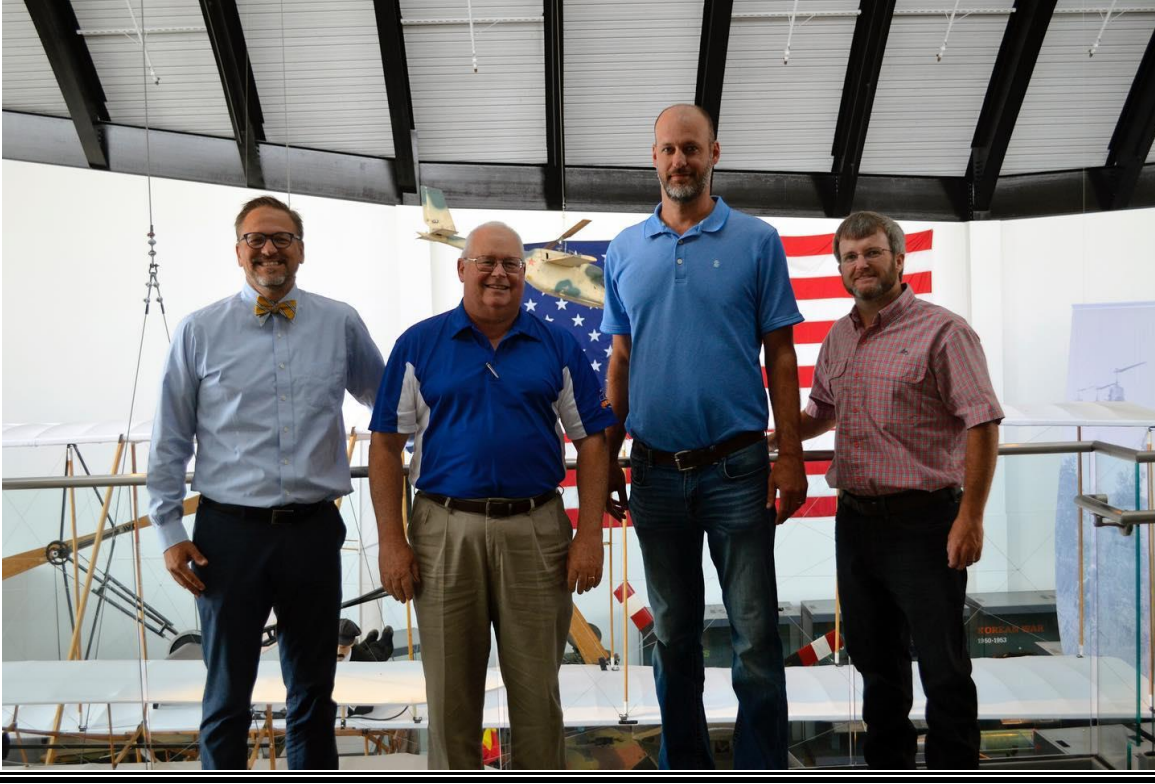

Dyersburg Water System, Dyer Public Works, Rutherford Water Department, and Union City Water & Wastewater also participated in the contest where each utility's water sample was judged on the quality of taste, clarity and bouquet.

This summer, TAUD will conduct the Best Tasting Water in Tennessee Contest in each of our eleven regions. The statewide winner represents TAUD at the Great American Taste Test held in conjunction with the National Rurally Water Association Rally in Washington DC in February of 2021.
