This training is designed to assist water and wastewater professionals in developing an Asset Management Plan (AMP) that meets the requirements of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) as well as discuss additional documentation needed during the submittal process. These workshops will be offered both virtually and hybrid in person to accommodate the schedules of utility personnel.

Training Objectives:

- Special emphasis will be placed on the development of a comprehensive asset management plan for ARPA grant submittal reimbursement. Material will review previous AMP sessions and offer utility personnel the opportunity to ask any final questions before grant closeout.
- Additional Critical Need Plans deliverables will be reviewed. These include Water Loss Control Plans, I/I Elimination Plans, Infrastructure Replacement Plans, and Reduction in Capacity Demand Plans. Utility personnel will be given the opportunity to ask questions related to these deliverables and the submittal process.
