This two-part course will teach the participants the proper methods to signal a crane or other lifting machinery using either hand signals or voice/radio commands. In addition, participants will learn basics of rigging and also the power line clearance requirements 1926.1407 -1926.1411 of the new standards. Participants will be tested as part of the class. All participants passing the class will receive a Basic Rigger/Signaler Training card.

The Qualified Signal Person session course focuses on the roles and responsibilities that signal persons have performing proper hand signals, for both mobile cranes and tower crane operations, and understanding voice commands as outlined in the new OSHA standard. The Qualified Rigger session designed to address fundamental rigging concepts and equipment to assist in increasing knowledge and abilities for an entry level rigger.
